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Employment Training Panel Approves Over \$10.2 Million to Support Workforce Training

SACRAMENTO – The State of California’s Employment Training Panel approved 79 contracts totaling over \$10.2 million in employment training funds at its monthly public meeting. Training proposals consisted of both single and multiple employer contracts from various industry sectors.

Funds approved today will be used by employers, educational facilities, and workforce training organizations to provide job skills training to more than 11,000 California workers. Trainees include new hires and incumbent workers in need of retraining. Some of the proposals included training for individuals who face multiple barriers to employment, which may include prior homelessness, former drug addiction, or military veterans making the transition to civilian life.

Asian Neighborhood Design, a non-profit architecture, community planning and employment training organization serving disadvantaged adults, young adults, and low-income residents with multiple barriers to employment in the San Francisco region was approved for \$171,492 in Employment Training Funds. Founded in 1973, Asian Neighborhood Design regularly provides one-on-one intensive case management, General Equivalency Degree preparation, ongoing support and up to one year job referral, job placement, and post-graduation retention aid to trainees who have at least two identified barriers to full-time employment.

Asian Neighborhood Design proposes to train 31 new hire trainees to develop construction, solar industry, and environmental services skills. Specific training will include green building practices, weatherization, deconstruction and conservation, carpentry, and solar PV installation. It will also incorporate environmental literacy in solar, energy-efficiency and zero-waste concepts. Trainees will gain industry experience in a lab environment and graduate with certifications giving them a better chance to secure jobs.

“For over 40 years, Asian Neighborhood Design has been changing the lives of emancipated youth and young adult residents and veterans with histories of incarceration, homelessness and recovery from substance abuse,” says Erica Roetman Sklar, Executive Director of Asian Neighborhood Design. “Funding from the Employment Training Panel will provide a critical lifeline to our clients and helps Asian Neighborhood Design further our mission of reducing poverty, revitalizing neighborhoods, building healthy communities and providing opportunities for low-income residents to become economically self-sufficient.”

ETP is a business and labor supported state agency that assists employers in strengthening their competitive edge in the economy by providing funds to partially off-set the costs of necessary job skills training. California’s ETP is a performance-based program, providing funds

for trainees who successfully complete training and are retained in good-paying jobs at or above a required wage base, for at least 90 days.

The program, funded by the Employment Training Tax paid by California employers, helps businesses threatened by out-of-state and international competition. The Panel also serves employers under its Special Employment Training Program, funding projects designed to improve skills and employment security of frontline workers in projects that do not meet standard employer/trainee eligibility requirements. Since its inception in 1983, the ETP program has provided approximately \$1.25 billion to train over 800,000 workers for more than 78,000 California companies.
