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**Employment Training Panel Approves More Than \$6.1 Million  
To Train 6,300 Workers**

*Glendale Community College and Santa Monica Community College District to Train 1,806 Workers*

SACRAMENTO – The State of California’s Employment Training Panel announced the approval of 16 job training contracts worth \$6,156,997 million for 6,302 workers. The panel awarded Glendale Community College and Santa Monica Community College District contracts to train workers in growing industries.

“ETP’s long-standing partnerships with community colleges across the state are critical to reaching employers and providing quality job training” said Stewart Knox, the Employment Training Panel’s Executive Director.

The panel approved a \$925,070 contract for the Professional Development Center of Glendale Community College to provide its customized, job specific training to 793 workers. Over the past 30 years, the center has trained more than 36,000 workers from 4,800 Southern California employers with funding from the Employment Training Panel. Nearly 82 percent of the 4,800 employers were small businesses. The new contract will support training in key industries including manufacturing, aerospace, warehousing, transportation and logistics, and services, as well as provide training for 80 veterans.

“The Employment Training Panel has benefited Roncelli Plastics greatly and enables our company to train our workforce at becoming more skilled in their craft,” said Joel Isaguirre, Quality Assurance Manager of Roncelli Plastics. “We are provided with expert trainers and classes that are tailored for our industry. We are grateful for this opportunity to participate with Glendale Community College in this program.”

The Santa Monica Community College District’s \$949,611 contract will provide job training to 1,013 workers. Employees from participating businesses will be receiving skills training in the manufacturing, logistics, construction, and healthcare industries. Medical skills training will be offered to licensed vocational nurses, therapists and registered nurses. This is their eighth contract with the Employment Training Panel.

The Employment Training Panel is the state’s premier program supporting job creation and retention through training. The panel reimburses employers for the costs of training existing workers, funds training for unemployed workers to re-enter the workforce and helps to ensure California businesses have the skilled workers they need to remain competitive.
